IHAVET OBJECTIVES

IHAVET aimed to contribute to reducing high education dropout in students with migrant backgrounds by creating a Validated European Toolkit.

The toolkit goal was to support students with a migration background, their parents and teachers/trainers/youth workers according to their roles and responsibilities on the problem of early school leaving (ESL).

IHAVET TOOLKIT

This toolkit was created to support all figures involved in education (formal, non-formal and informal) of students with a migrant background and youth themselves. IHAVET provided an updated toolkit to better understand and face the daily challenges of all actors involved in ESL issues.

The toolkit was tested during a short-time training in Greece, with the direct involvement of parents, students and trainers/youth workers, to stimulate a more proactive attitude.

Moreover, the event was the opportunity to discuss the output produced by the research activities, to identify best practices and to involve the target groups in the decision making process.
